CGI files 2020 Annual Disclosure Documents

Montréal, Quebec, December 18, 2020 - CGI (TSX: GIB.A) (NYSE: GIB) today filed with the securities regulators in Canada and in the United States its Management Proxy Circular for its Annual General Meeting of Shareholders that will be held on January 27, 2021.

CGI also filed its 2020 Annual Information Form with the Canadian securities regulators and its Fiscal 2020 Results (referred to herein as its "2020 Annual Report") on Form 40-F with the U.S. Securities and Exchange Commission.
