

Alliant Energy Annual Meeting of Shareowners

Rules of Conduct

Attendance: Only shareowners of record as of March 27, 2020, will be permitted to attend.

Meeting Conduct: The meeting will strictly follow the agenda. The only business to be conducted are the matters set forth in the Notice of Annual Meeting of Stockholders and Proxy Statement, dated April 9, 2020. Proposals or nominations made during the meeting will not be taken up unless they were properly submitted in advance according to the company's bylaws or SEC.

Questions: Shareowners may ask questions of the Chairman, President and CEO any time prior to the meeting by using the "Ask a Question" box on your screen. Fifteen minutes have been allocated at the end of the meeting to answer questions from shareowners. Questions will be addressed by the Chairman, President and CEO at the Annual Meeting.

Guidelines for questions:

- Questions should relate to the meeting or the company's business or strategy.
- Questions are limited to the number of characters available in the box.
- Questions should not:
 - Be about topics other than company's business, operations or strategy.
 - Relate to employee or retiree benefits.
 - Further personal interests that may not be of interest to all shareowners.
 - Be rude or derogatory.
- Questions that do not follow these guidelines can be ruled out of order.
- Questions that are similar to each other will be grouped together and answered once.

Recording: Recording of the Annual Meeting is prohibited. Alliant Energy will post a playback of the meeting on our investor website.
