**Rules of Conduct**

Every stockholder wishing to vote or ask questions during our annual meeting will have the opportunity to do so by the following rules of conduct:

1. Only stockholders as of the close of business on March 13, 2024, may submit questions and vote while attending our annual meeting via the Internet. Stockholders will need to enter the 16-digit control number received with their proxy materials to demonstrate proof of stock ownership.
2. If you have voted your shares prior to the start of the meeting, your vote has been received by the Company's inspector of elections and there is no need to vote those shares during the meeting, unless you wish to revoke or change your vote.
3. During the presentation of the stockholder proposal, the stockholder or its representative will have three minutes to present the proposal. The stockholder or its representative should restrict its comments to the stockholder proposal being presented.
4. Stockholders who wish to ask a question during the question-and-answer period should submit their questions in the field provided in the online meeting tool.
5. Depending on the volume of questions received during the meeting, questions received from attendees will be read aloud and answered as time allows. Questions from multiple stockholders on the same topic or that are otherwise related may be grouped, summarized, and answered together.
6. Your cooperation will be appreciated and will help make the meeting a useful forum for communicating with AMD's management and Board of Directors.
